Session Abstract

Companies have always faced compliance requirements in one form or another. Individual efforts for SOX, or PCI, or NERC, are difficult enough. But most organizations face a mountain of additional regulatory scrutiny. The compounding effect of today's complex regulatory maze is overwhelming forcing even the strongest organizations into reactionary postures that are barely sustainable. Inadequate policy and compliance programs increase exposure risk not only to compliance fines and litigation but reputational and long term financial impacts.
