Session Synopsis

Salesforce.com deployed a bespoke Agile Development Method in 2008 / 2009, referred to as Adaptive Design Methodology (ADM). The ADM is a modified Scrum/XP (Extreme Programming) style of product development and has enabled SFDC to deliver greater functionality more frequently to its customers. The ADM framework, adopts certain XP practices and is rooted in lean principles, these principles have enabled:

- The elimination of waste
- Build quality in
- Respect People
- Create knowledge
- Just-in-time decision making
- Deliver value quickly
- Flexibility and responsiveness in R&D teams
- Predictable and reliable
- Feature priority
- Deliver more of the right value, more often.

With the deployment of this methodology there were a number of challenges associated with the controls environment, how the new methodology could be tested to verify that the processes were under control and that the processes met the requirements of ISO 27001 and other such standards. This session, walks the audience through the ADM process and discusses the controls within the processes and ultimately how the methodology is audited.
